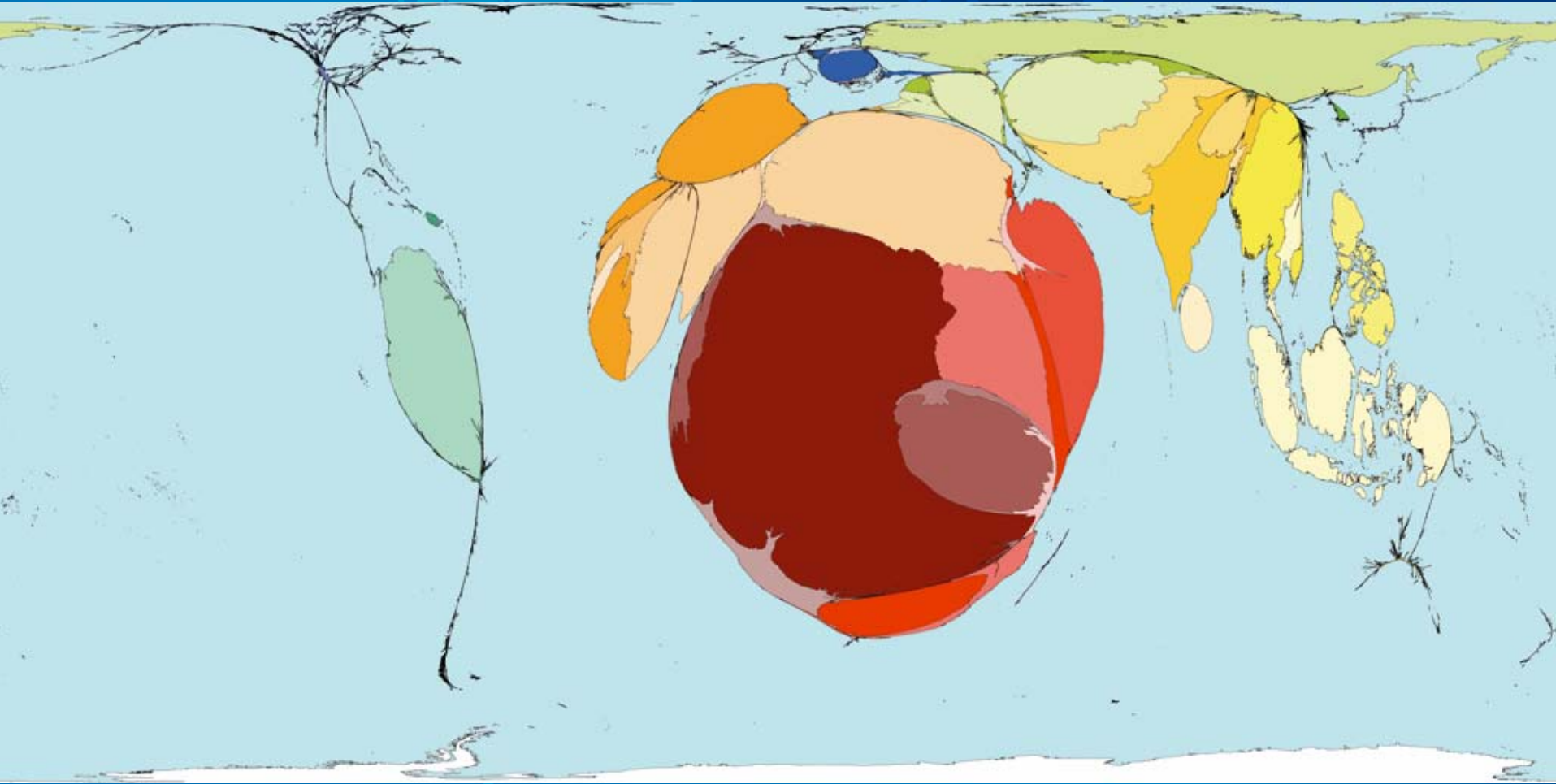

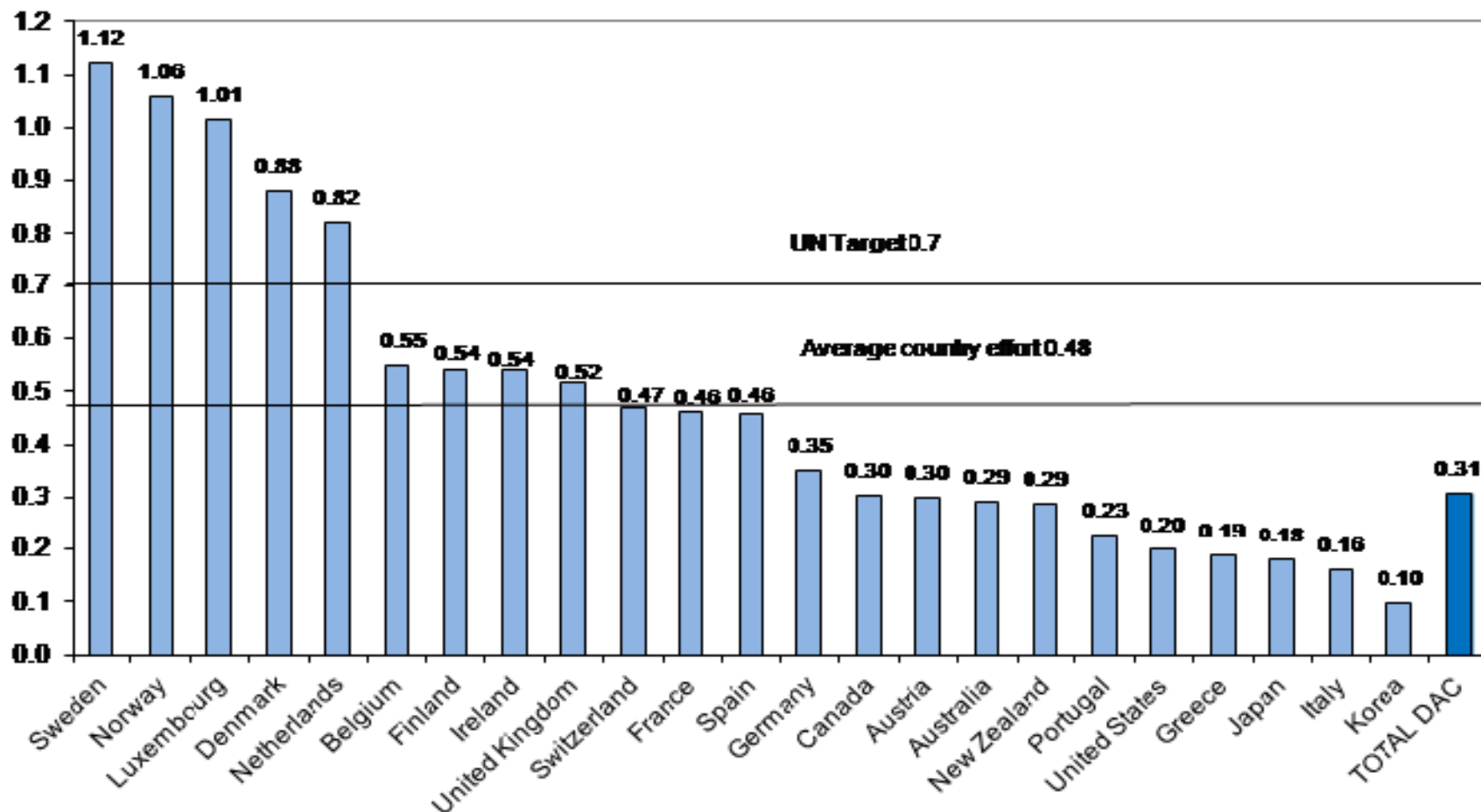
Net ODA – Amounts IN 2009

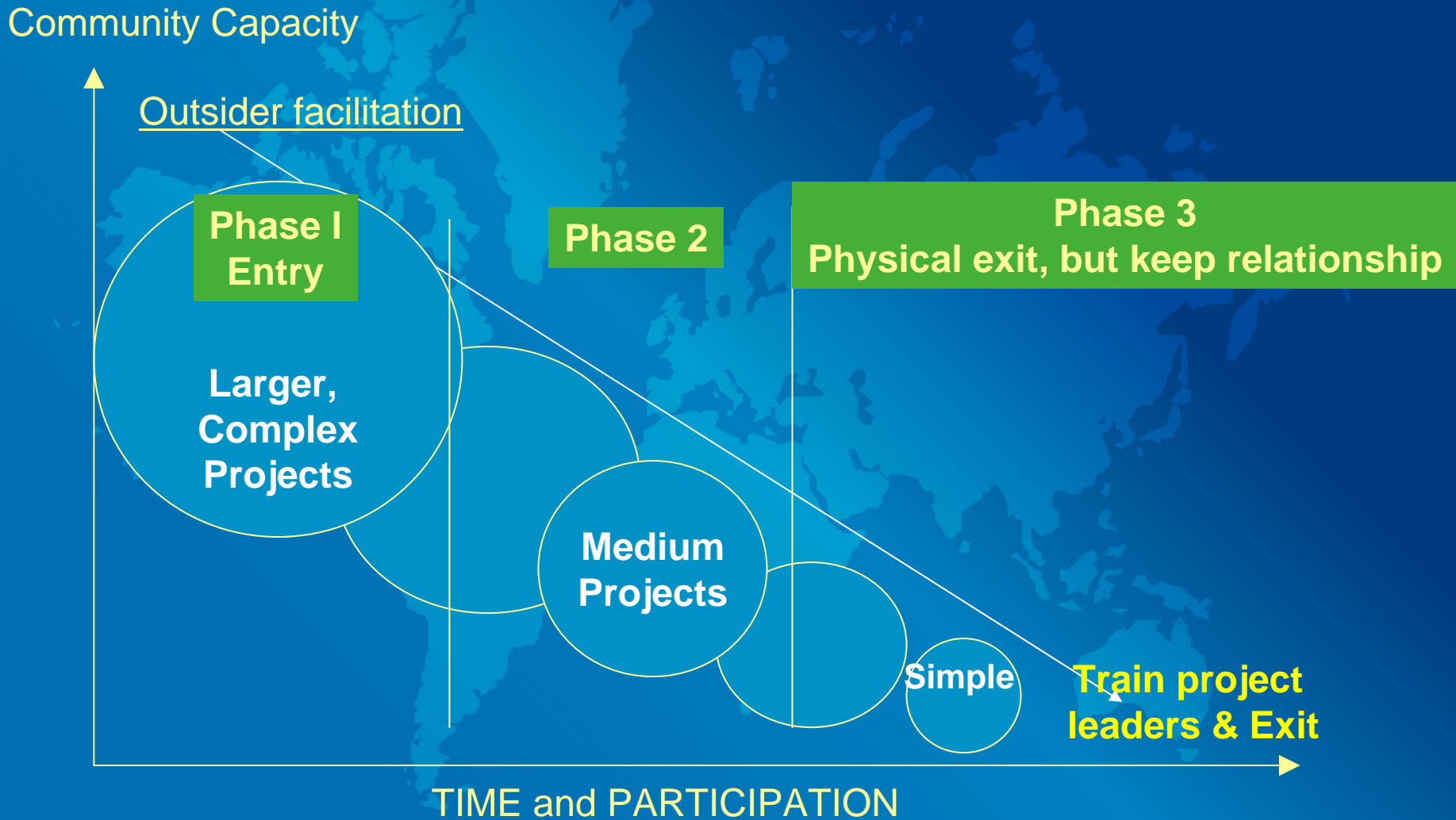
