- 3. Manuscripts from academic staffs of Ritsumeikan University, members of the research project sponsored by the Institute, postgraduate students of Ritsumeikan University and those who are requested to write for the journal by the editor-in-chief will be considered.
- 4. Manuscripts should be in printed and in electronic form.
- 5. Manuscripts shall not be returned to the author.
- 6. Please do not submit manuscripts via facsimile.
- 7. The Institute will not consider manuscripts whose content has been, or will be, published in another journal before it appears in *Ritsumeikan International Affairs*.
- 8. Please fill out the form of submission, which is obtainable at the Institute its website
- 9. Upper limits are eight thousands words for articles, five thousands words for research notes, and two thousand words for book reviews.
- 10. Summary of some 150 words and five keywords should be included in manuscripts.
